CAMPFIRES

You can have campfires in many of our camping areas, as long as you use your own fireplace, above ground that catches all ashes/coal and debris and causes no damage to the ground, our campfire circles or existing fire locations. Help us protect our campsite by bringing clean firewood and kindling with you or using fallen debris or campfire materials already stored around the campsite. All coal/ashes and debris from an above ground fireplace must not be dumped on the ground, beside trees or in long grass. Please put all coal/ashes and fire debris into our campfire circles or designated locations. Ask the Caretaker for more information.



Campfires must not be lit on the ground or damage the ground in any way



Campfire ash/coal must not be placed onto the ground anywhere



Campfires must be in a fireplace with an ash/coal catching device off the ground, that prevents damage to the ground



Campfires must be attended at all times



Water must be available at all times for urgent extinguishing of fire



Place all used ash/coal into existing campfire circles or designated locations only – ask the Caretaker



\$50 charge for each instance of damage to ground caused by a fire or ash/coal dumped on the ground
